

There have been some stellar performances by our rowing members in the recently concluded championships. They have fought against all odds and set an example to keep the spirits high in all situations.

All India Inter-State University Rowing Championship, Chandigarh, 2022.

Pratik Gupta and Shweta Brahmachari won Gold Medals in the Men's and Women's single scull event respectively, over a distance of 2000 m, held at Sukhna Lake, Chandigarh, this March. In the 500 m category both of them won Silver medals in the Men's and Women's single scull event. They beat the Senior national medalists in this championship .



8th Netaji Subhash State Games 2022.

Lake Club won a total of 10 medals and topped the medals tally with 4 Golds and 6 Silvers at the State Games organised by the Bengal Olympic Association (BOA) in association with WBRA, in May.

The 23rd Sub-Junior & 5th Inter-State Challenger

Nationals 2022 held in Jammu & Kashmir, in June 2022.

475 rowers from 23 States of India participated in this National Championship.

The West Bengal Rowing Team comprised of 28 rowers , out of which 10 rowers were from the Lake Club .

The team travelled to the state of Jammu & Kashmir without any on-water training, as all rowing activities were suspended by the civic authorities after the tragic incident on 21st May, 2022. Despite being unable to practise on boats , three crews from the Lake Club made it to the finals and two of them won Silver and Bronze medals. The Challenger Women's Coxless Fours also made to the finals and secured the fourth place.

Our heartfelt thanks to the Captain, Chief Coach , their team members and all the rowing members of the club for their resilience and steadfast determination.



The Intra Club Family Cricket Tournament was held inside the Indoor Sports Complex from 9th to 13th May. Members, their spouses and children enthusiastically came forward to play in the tournament, which took place after two years. There was much excitement surrounding the Matches and the Sports Complex remained packed to its capacity . Man of the Match award was given after every match both in the league and knock out series. This was to encourage the players.

The team under the Captainship of Shakil Ahmed won the Runner up trophy. The Champions trophy was won by the team under the Captainship of Debnath Halder.

All the players of the Finalist teams were given individual medals and bags. Apart from this, several individual prizes in different categories were given. The credit for the success of the tournament goes to the exuberance and discipline shown by both the players and the spectators. To mark the grand finale, a gala Calypso Night was organised to mesmerize the crowd with the energetic performance of the renowned singer, Mr Sumit Roy.
